Applicants must submit the following when making an application:

- Completed application form with **valid email address**
- **Two** passport photographs (actual not scanned copies)
- Copy of valid passport
- Copy of Seaman's Discharge Book (for experienced seafarer route only)
- Copy of Degree Certificate and LIA (for graduate route only)
- Engine Room Watch Rating Certificate (STCW Reg. III/4)
- Basic STCW safety training certificates;
 - I. Personal Survival Techniques (STCW Code A-VI/1-1);
 - II. Fire Prevention and Fire Fighting (STCW Code A-VI/1-2);
 - III. Elementary First Aid (STCW Code A-VI/1-3); and
 - IV. Personal Safety and Social Responsibilities (STCW Code A-VI/1-4).
- **International applicants** are required to pay a non-refundable deposit of £1000
- Medical Fitness Certificate (ENG1) or MCA recognised equivalent certificate.
- Security Awareness Certificate (STCW Code A-VI/6-1, paragraph 4);

Note: Engine room seagoing service consisting of cleaning duties **only** will not be accepted towards this training programme.
